

He has also renovated the humble church of Sainte-Marie-Madeleine with an original touch. How did he erect such buildings? Whispers say he found a treasure..

# **Arques Castle**

With its elegant dungeon and its magnificent Logis Tower, the castle entirely restored is a masterpiece of gothic military construction from the 13th century. This fortified house has been classified as historical site of France since 1887 and Cathar Country Site.



growth which change forever the region at the Tertiary era.


# Salted Source, Sougraigne


